**Subject-specific Course and Examination
Regulations for the joint Master's programme
“Global Technology and Innovation Management &
Entrepreneurship” at the Hamburg University of
Technology (TUHH) (FSPO-JMTIE)**

As per 25 July 2018

Preamble

The Executive Board of the Hamburg University of Technology (TUHH) approved the subject-specific provisions for the course and examination regulations for the joint course “Global Technology and Innovation Management & Entrepreneurship” leading to a “Master of Science” degree as per section 108, paragraph 1 of the Hamburg Higher Education Act (HmbHG) on 22 August 2018. The provisions were decided by the TUHH Academic Senate on 25 July 2018 pursuant to section 85, paragraph 1.1 HmbHG of 18 July 2001 (HmbGVbl., p. 171) in the version dated 29 May 2018 (HmbGVbl., p. 200).

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Section 1 Scope

- (1) These subject-specific provisions for the course and examination regulations (FSPO) apply to the joint course “Global Technology and Innovation Management & Entrepreneurship” leading to a “Master of Science” degree.
- (2) These subject-specific provisions for the course and examination regulations (FSPO) apply in addition to the valid version of the General Study and Examination Regulations (ASPO) for Bachelor’s and Master’s Courses at the Hamburg University of Technology (TUHH) dated 22 November 2017.

Section 2 Structure of the course and partner universities

- (1) In this two-year joint Master’s programme, students first enrol at the Hamburg University of Technology (TUHH), where they complete the first two semesters. The third and fourth semesters are completed at one of the partner universities. The Master’s dissertation is written during the second year of study at the corresponding partner university.
- (2) The following partner universities are involved in addition to the Hamburg University of Technology (TUHH):
 - a. University of Strathclyde (UoS) in Glasgow, Scotland/UK
 - b. Kaunas University of Technology (KTU) in Kaunas, Lithuania

- c. Manipal University (MU) in Manipal, India
- d. Associated: Aalborg University (AAU) in Aalborg, Denmark
- e. Associated: Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (APU) in Beppu, Japan

Section 3 Responsible bodies

- (1) Department
The responsible body is the School of Management Sciences and Technology.
- (2) Board of Examiners
The responsible body is the Board of Examiners of the School of Management Sciences and Technology.
- (3) Course guidance
Study advisers are appointed by the board of the School of Management Sciences and Technology.
- (4) The partner universities listed under Section 2 (2) are responsible for coordinating the second year of study.

Section 4 Academic degree

Depending on the chosen specialisation and the corresponding partner university, the following academic degrees will be awarded following successful completion of all Master’s examinations:

Section 5 Examinations and coursework at the TUHH

The curriculum in the annex of this FSPO provides details of the types of examinations and coursework, and their credit point values, required to graduate with a Master of Science degree.

Section 6 Examinations and coursework at partner universities

- (1) The examinations and coursework to be completed in the third and fourth semesters at the partner universities as per Section 2 (2)a to (2)c are detailed in the curriculum applicable to the relevant specialisation. The valid version of the applicable partner university’s examination arrangements shall apply.

- (2) A limited number of students can also complete the third and fourth semesters at one of the two associated partner universities as per Section 2 (2)d and (2)e. Students are selected to spend these two semesters at the Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University, Japan, or the Aalborg University, Denmark, in a competition. The valid version of the applicable partner university's examination arrangements shall apply.

Section 7 Final thesis (dissertation)

- (1) The Master's thesis will be written at the partner university as per Section 2 (2) where the student has spent the second year of study. Work undertaken as part of the Master's thesis is worth 30 credit points.
- (2) The applicable examination regulations of the partner universities apply for the Master's thesis. If the Master's thesis is written at one of the associated partner universities as per Section 2 (2)d and (2)e, a second examiner from the TUHH is required.

Section 8 Diploma, Certificate, Diploma Supplement

- (1) Sections 32 and 33 of the ASPO shall apply with the following additions:
 - a. Graduates whose qualification is a Double Degree will receive separate diplomas, certificates and diploma supplements from both partner universities from the first and second years of study. Each university will separately award the graduate these documents.
 - b. Graduates whose qualification is a Joint Degree will receive a joint diploma, certificate and diploma supplement from both partner universities from the first and second years of study. These are solely issued by the TUHH in English, and are signed and stamped by both universities. The TUHH will award graduates these documents.
 - c. The TUHH will issue graduates who spend their second year of study at an associated partner university as per Section 2 (2)d and (2)e with a diploma, certificate and diploma supplement. The graduates also receive a certificate of attendance from the associated partner university. The TUHH will award graduates the diploma, certificate and diploma supplement. The associated partner university will award the certificate of attendance.

Section 9 Effective date

- (1) This FSPO is in effect from 1 October 2018.
- (2) The curricula for the joint Master's programme "Global Technology and Innovation Management & Entrepreneurship" at the TUHH in the current versions are included as an annex and form part of this FSPO. The effective dates of the curricula are regulated in the annexes.
